Exodus 34:31-35—“But Moses called to them...and he spoke to them...When Moses finished speaking to them, he put a veil over his face. But whenever he entered the Lord’s presence to speak with Him, he removed the veil until he came out...Then Moses would put the veil back over his face until he went in to speak with the Lord.”

II Corinthians 3:13—“We are not like Moses, who would put a veil over his face to prevent the Israelites from seeing the end of what was passing away.”

II Corinthians 3:14-15—“But their minds were made dull, for to this day the same veil remains when the Old Covenant is read. It has not been removed, because only in Christ is it taken away. Even to this day when Moses is read, a veil covers their hearts.”

II Corinthians 4:4—“The god of this age has blinded the minds of unbelievers, so that they cannot see the light of the gospel that displays the glory of Christ...”
