THE CHASE—PART 4 "WHAT ARE YOU DOING HERE?" Pastor Andy Shaffer—April 28, 2024

I Kings 19:3—"Elijah was afraid and ran for his life..."

<u>I Kings 18:21</u>—"Elijah went before the people and said, 'How long will you waver between two opinions? If the Lord is God, <u>follow Him</u>; but if Baal is God, <u>follow him</u>.' But the people said nothing."

<u>I Kings 19:1-4</u>—"Now Ahab told Jezebel everything Elijah had done and how he had killed all the prophets with the sword. So Jezebel sent a messenger to Elijah to say, 'May the gods deal with me, be it ever so severely, if by this time tomorrow I do not make your life like that of one of them.'

<u>Elijah was afraid and ran for his life</u>. When he came to Beersheba in Judah, he left his servant there, while he himself <u>went a day's journey into the wilderness</u>. He came to a broom bush, sat down under it and <u>prayed that he might die</u>. '<u>I have had enough</u>, Lord,' he said. 'Take my life; I am no better than my ancestors...'"

God Said...

1) Get Up And Eat!

I Kings 19:5—"Then he lay down under the bush and fell asleep. All at once an angel touched him and said, 'Get up and eat.""

<u>I Kings 19:6-7</u>—"He looked around, and there <u>by his head was some bread</u> baked over hot coals, and a jar of water. He ate and drank and then lay down again. The angel of <u>the Lord came back a second time and touched him</u> and said, '<u>Get up and eat</u>, for the journey is too much for you."

The Big Idea:
God's Given Us His Word—We Have To Choose To Eat It!

2) Go Out And Stand!

<u>I Kings 19:8-9</u>—"So <u>he got up and ate and drank</u>. Strengthened by that food, he traveled forty days and forty nights until he reached Horeb, <u>the mountain of God</u>. There <u>he went into a cave</u> and spent the night. And the word of the Lord came to him: '<u>What are you doing here</u>, Elijah?'"

<u>I Kings 19:10</u>—"He replied, '<u>I have been very zealous for the Lord</u> God Almighty. The Israelites have rejected your covenant, torn down your altars, and put your prophets to death with the sword. <u>I am the only one left</u>, and now they are trying to kill me too."

<u>I Kings 19:11-13</u>—"The Lord said, 'Go out and stand on the mountain in the presence of the Lord, for the Lord is about to pass by.' Then a great and powerful wind tore the mountains apart and shattered the rocks before the Lord, but <u>the Lord was not in the wind</u>. After the wind there was an earthquake, but <u>the Lord was not in the earthquake</u>. After the earthquake came a fire, but <u>the Lord was not in the fire</u>. And after the fire came <u>a gentle whisper</u>.

When Elijah heard it, he pulled his cloak over his face and went out and <u>stood at the mouth of the cave</u>.

Then a voice said to him, 'What are you doing here, Elijah?"

"I whisper because I'm close!"

3) Go Back The Way You Came!

<u>I Kings 19:15</u>—"The Lord said to him, '<u>Go back the way you came</u>, and go to the Desert of Damascus. When you get there, anoint Hazael king over Aram."

<u>II Corinthians 4:8-9</u>—"We are <u>hard pressed on every side, but not crushed;</u> perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed."
