

JOURNEY GROUP DISCUSSION GUIDE
TWISTED—PART 3
“Plans To Prosper You...”

Icebreaker: What does **Jeremiah 29:11** say? Other than Sunday, where have you seen or heard this verse? What came to your mind when you heard it & how did it make you feel?

- As a child, what did you want to be when you grew up? What were your plans as you grew into adulthood? Did those plans change, or have they worked out? Talk about it.

- What’s something that stood out to you or impacted you from the message on Sunday?

1) Read **Jeremiah 29:11-13**.

Why do you think we like to *“twist”* the promise of **verse 11** as if it’s specifically for me?

Why is it a problem for us to think every promise in the Bible is written specifically **to me**? What does it lead people to believe about God, or how do they react if it doesn’t happen? Has that ever happened to you? Discuss.

Would you rather serve a God whose plans always line up with your plans, or would you rather serve a God who promises to always be with you no matter what? Explain your answer.

What plans do you have for God that you need to swap with His plans for you?

What’s the general promise of **verses 12-13**? How do you seek God with all your heart—what does that look like?

Where do you need to see God's goodness in your life right now?

How can you apply this message to your life this week?

Close in prayer (pray that God will reveal Himself to you, even if it's in the midst of a trial or a struggle).
